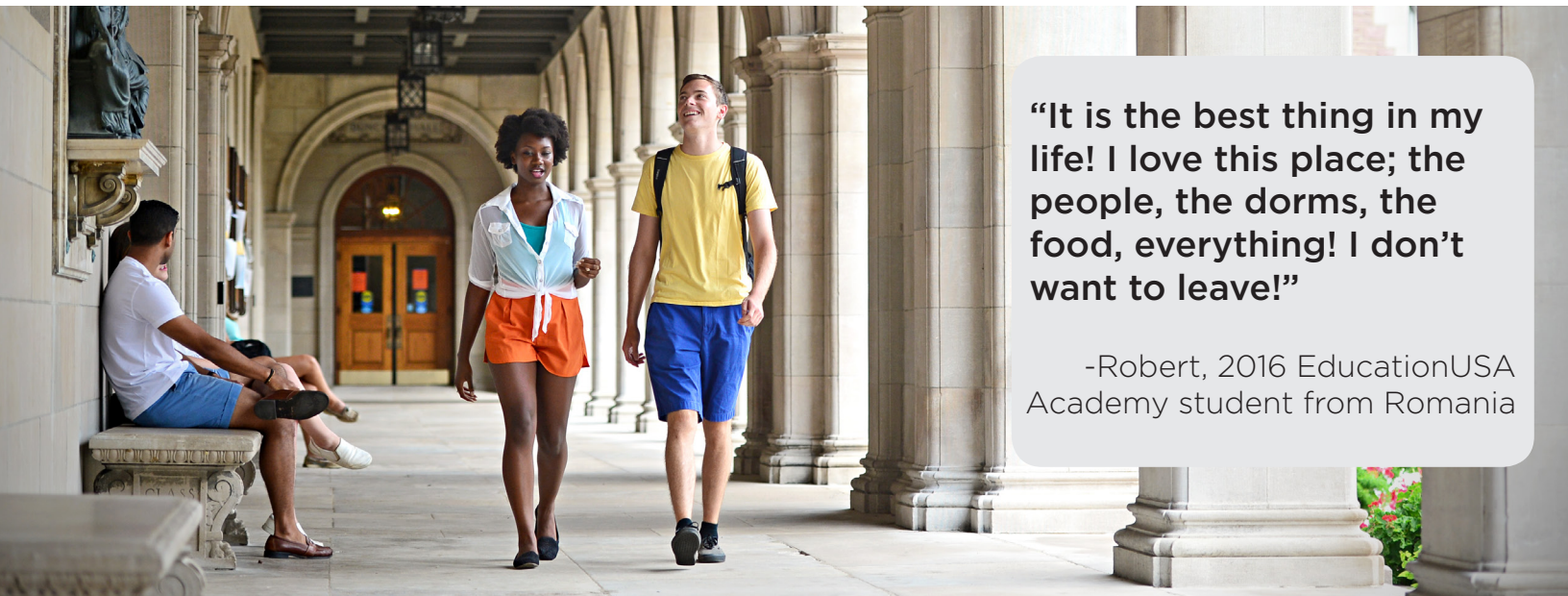


# EducationUSA Academy at Washington University in St. Louis

## About EducationUSA Academy at Washington University

The noncredit EducationUSA Academy at Washington University is a three-week, residential summer program designed for international students seeking to improve their English proficiency while learning about the American college experience. Through a variety of specialized program activities, students will network with Washington University faculty and staff and learn to conduct undergraduate level research. Activities include:

- Intensive English training course
- Globally focused discussions
- STEAM and innovation themed days
- Workshops on the college admissions essay
- TOEFL preparation
- Visits to other Saint Louis area colleges and universities
- American cultural experiences

## Eligibility

- Current high school student between the ages of 15-17
- Currently living outside of the United States
- Minimum B+ GPA
- TOEFL score of at least 60

## Program Fee and Dates

The dates for the program are July 16-August 4, 2017. The total program fee, which includes all academic and residential expenses is \$5,585. Scholarship assistance is available for students who demonstrate financial need.

## 2017 Important Deadlines

### February 15

Early bird application deadline

(apply by this date and the \$35 application fee is waived)

### April 1

Application deadline

### April 1

Scholarship application deadline

### May 1

Deposit deadline

### June 1

Balance paid in full deadline

We review applications on a rolling basis. Qualified applicants are admitted until all spaces in a program are filled.

*Please note:* Many of our programs fill before the April 1 application deadline, so we strongly encourage students to apply early.

After a student is admitted, a \$500 nonrefundable deposit is due by May 1 to hold the student’s spot in the program.
